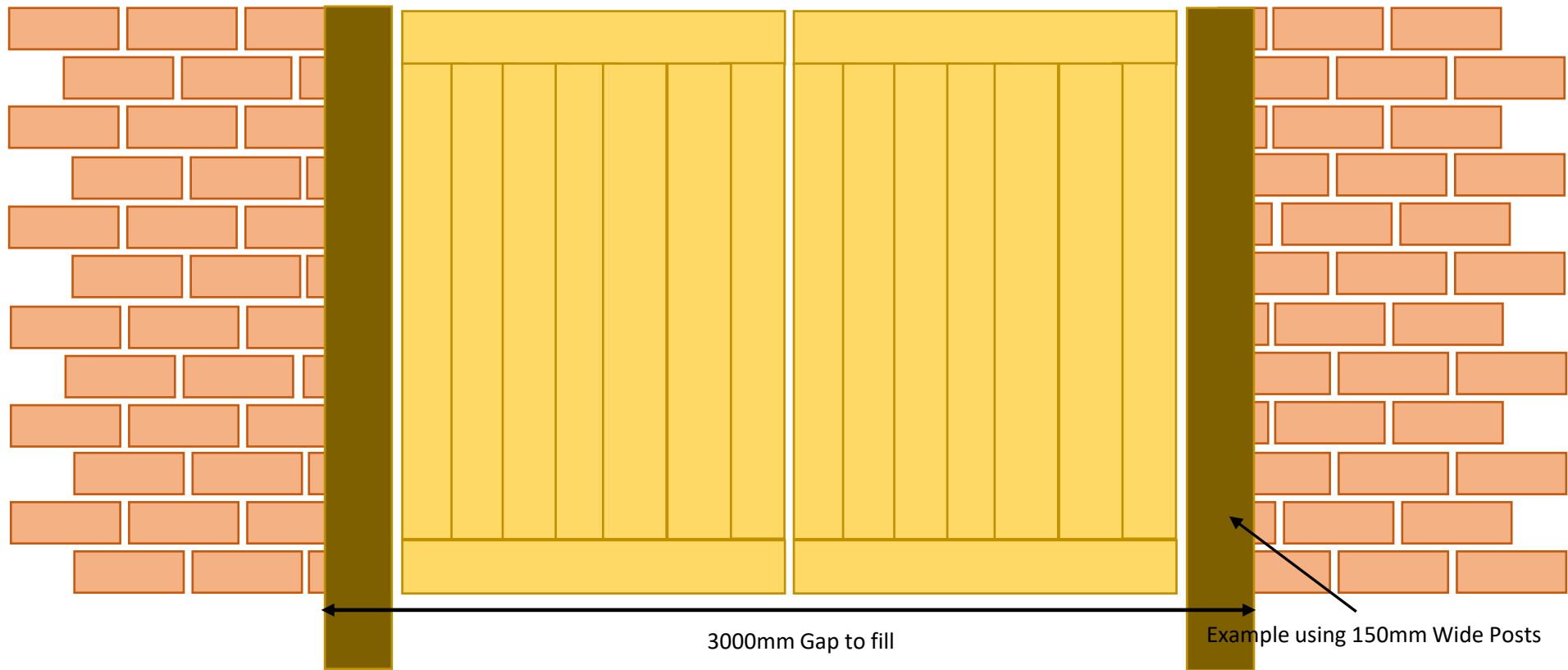


How to Measure for Double Gates Using New Posts



Firstly decide what height you would like your gates. We recommend allowing a 50mm ground clearance.

Measure the width of the gap you need to fill. In this example it is 3000mm.

Calculation goes like this: $3000\text{mm} - 150\text{mm (left gate post)} - 150\text{mm (right gate post)} - 30\text{mm (hinge/latch tolerance)} = 2670\text{mm}$

Divide this by 2 to give you the size of each gate leaf = 1335mm wide.

If opening out, hinges must be placed on the face of the posts. If opening inwards, then placed on the back of the posts. The calculation remains the same for either method.

30mm tolerance is what we advise but you can go slightly smaller or bigger. Never go less than 20mm as the gate can swell in wet weather.
