## 3 Tier Raised Bed Kit



Use hex head provided to screw structural screws through the predrilled holes. There is only one hole on each section of wood. Make sure all prominent holes are on the outside, not inside of the bed. The colours indicate matching size timbers. Some layers may use 4 pieces the same size depending on size kit ordered. Check which size kit you ordered.





Once you're happy you have stacked each layer correctly, secure the 6 battens supplied with the nails provided on the inside which keep the layers secured together.
